


Praise God!



Something Began to Shift

When Dre arrived at Crossroads Kids Club, he was new to the school and neighborhood, and **looking for somewhere to belong.**

He came from a divided home, and stability—school routines, familiar faces, a place to land—was something he hadn't known yet.

He wandered, sometimes literally, slipping out of rooms, untethered.

His anger flared up easily. He pushed limits and moved through the day like he was waiting for something to go wrong.

But Dre **continued to return to Crossroads.** He heard stories about Jesus. He listened to prayers spoken aloud. And something—**slow and unseen**—began to shift.

One afternoon, unprompted, **Dre walked up to a leader and said, "I can lead the 'Who is Jesus?"** He had memorized the full gospel declaration, complete with hand motions. So they let him.

At the year's final club, **he surrendered his life to Christ** and went to church the next Sunday with his mother.

The wandering stopped. The Word had settled somewhere deep.

And Dre stood still—rooted, finally, in the light.





When They Keep Showing Up

At Hamilton's school, some kids didn't always have enough to eat.

Crossroads saw that and started serving full dinners at club—not just snacks. Hamilton came hungry, and he kept coming.

The leaders kept showing up, too. Not just for club, but during lunch and recess. They learned names, asked questions, and stayed longer than they had to. Hamilton noticed.

Over time, he **started to talk more, stay longer, and trust them**. He began listening more closely during the lessons. *Sometimes he lingered after the others had run off to the gym*. A shift was happening that was **gradual, but clear.**

Then, late in the year, during a club meeting, **Hamilton asked to pray** with a leader. It wasn't something he'd planned. But the message that day stayed with him, and he didn't want to leave without responding.

He responded to Jesus with open arms at that moment.

But it wasn't just about that afternoon. It was about **all the weeks that** came before—and the path ahead, now lit with something new.

From Silence to Strength

Sharay lives in Guadalajara, Mexico.

She grew up in a home ruled by chaos.

Her father's addictions made the house feel unsafe—marked by insults, violence, and fear.

From an early age, Sharay learned to survive by going silent.

The pain was constant, and eventually, she turned it inward. Hurting herself became a way to cope. She did things she now knows were wrong, but at the time, it felt like the only way through.

She had known the church as a child, but when a Crossroads Kids Club started near her home in Mexico, something shifted.

She returned. Week by week, she watched the leaders show up with **kindness and faith**, and for the *first time in a long time, she felt drawn in*.

Slowly, her heart began to heal.

It didn't undo the past. But the weight of it began to crack under something stronger than what she'd carried alone. Now she serves other kids walking paths like hers. And even when it hurts to remember, she keeps going—because God carried her, and she knows he can carry them, too.

Spreading the Light Globally

While Crossroads Kids Club remains focused on reaching children in U.S. public schools, **God has opened unexpected doors around the world**—and we're following his lead.

It began in 2018, when the Lord used a connection in Chicago to introduce us to Pastor Rolando González in Mexico. That relationship has grown into something beautiful, producing lasting fruit like **Sharay's transformed life** (opposite page) and many others who have encountered Christ's love.

As we've sought to remain faithful to serve where the Lord opens doors, opportunities have multiplied. Today, children in **Guatemala, El Salvador, Honduras, Ghana,** and **Zambia** are hearing the Good News in their own languages through local leaders we've equipped and empowered to carry out the same Crossroads model.

focusing on under-resourced areas where local
leadership shares our passion for reaching
children.

At Crossroads Kids Club, we keep financial reserves on hand for two important reasons:

- 1. Cash flow timing. Most of our donations arrive during year-end and spring campaigns, but ministry expenses continue steadily all year. Reserves allow us to cover operations during slower giving seasons like summer and fall.
- 2. Stability and flexibility. We maintain an operating reserve as a safeguard to ensure ministry continues even in the face of unexpected challenges and to respond quickly when God opens new doors.
